### Learning Together Program Process Guidelines:

We are pleased that you are interested in having your child participate in the HCPSS Learning Together Program (LTP). This program provides a developmentally appropriate educational program for children with disabilities and typically developing children. Three- and four- year-old children may participate.

The [online LTP Application](#) is available starting February 11, 2021. Priority will be given to applications submitted by **April 1st**. For the 2021-2022 school year, you will be completing only one application for your child which will allow you to apply to multiple schools. This process will also allow families to select which schools may work for your family's needs. HCPSS is committed to providing instruction based on the statewide Early Learning Standards which are in alignment with Kindergarten Readiness. The fees listed in the application will be collected monthly regardless of the learning model determined throughout the 2021-22 school year (virtual, hybrid, or normal operations).

The Howard County Public School System also offers a prekindergarten option for children who meet income eligibility and will be **four years old by September 1**.
